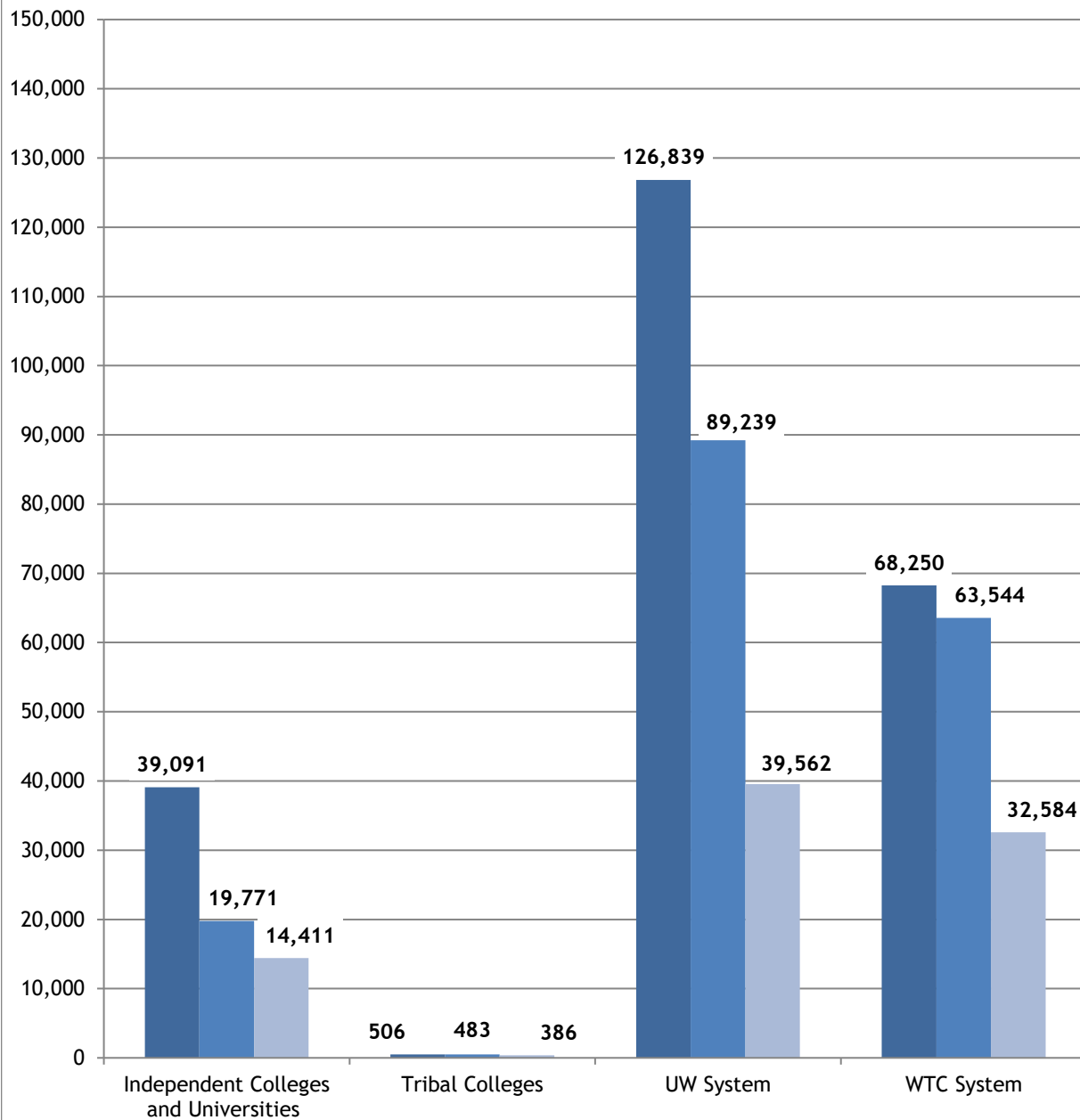


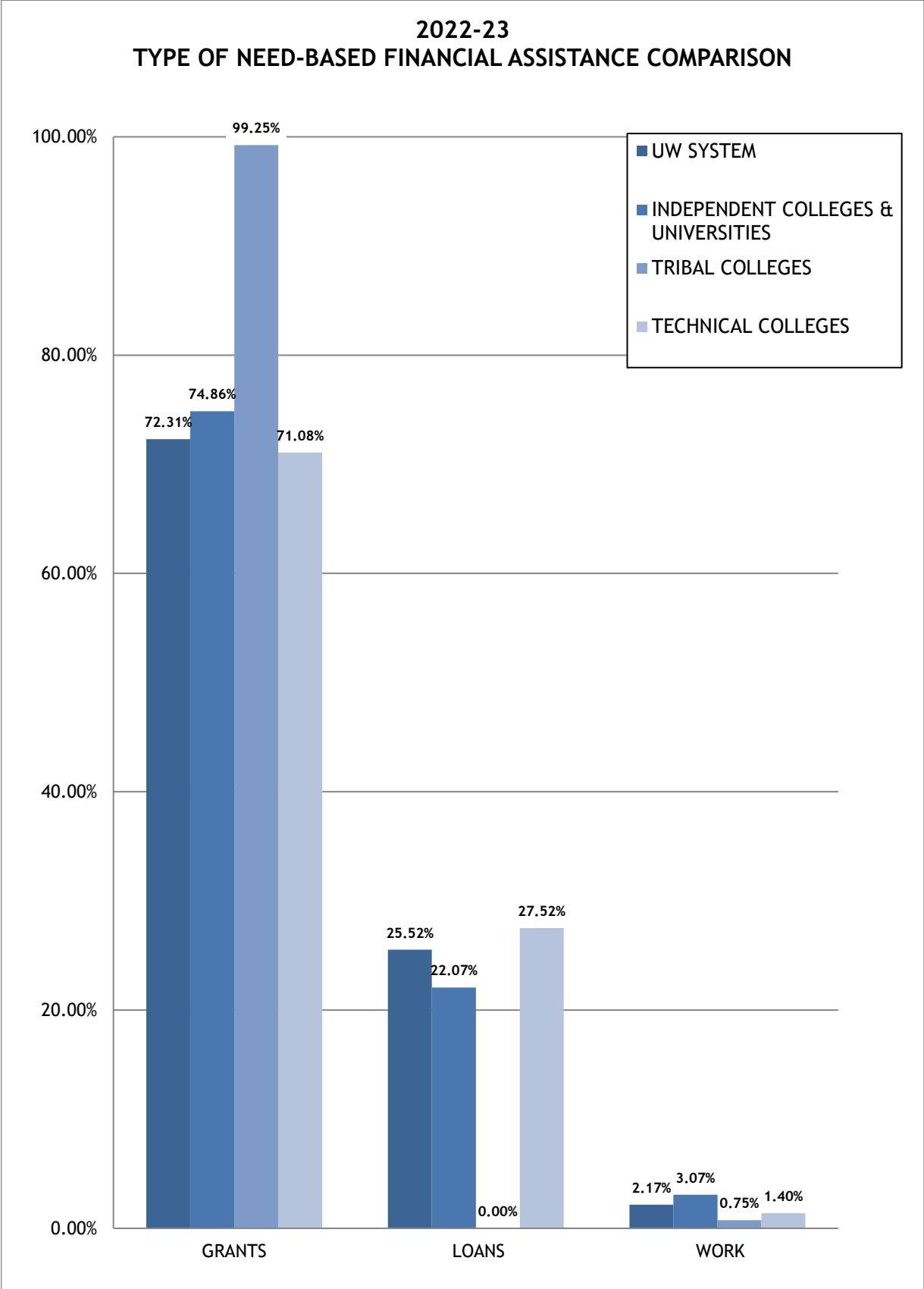




### 2022-23 Number of Wisconsin Residents who Applied for and Received Need-Based Aid

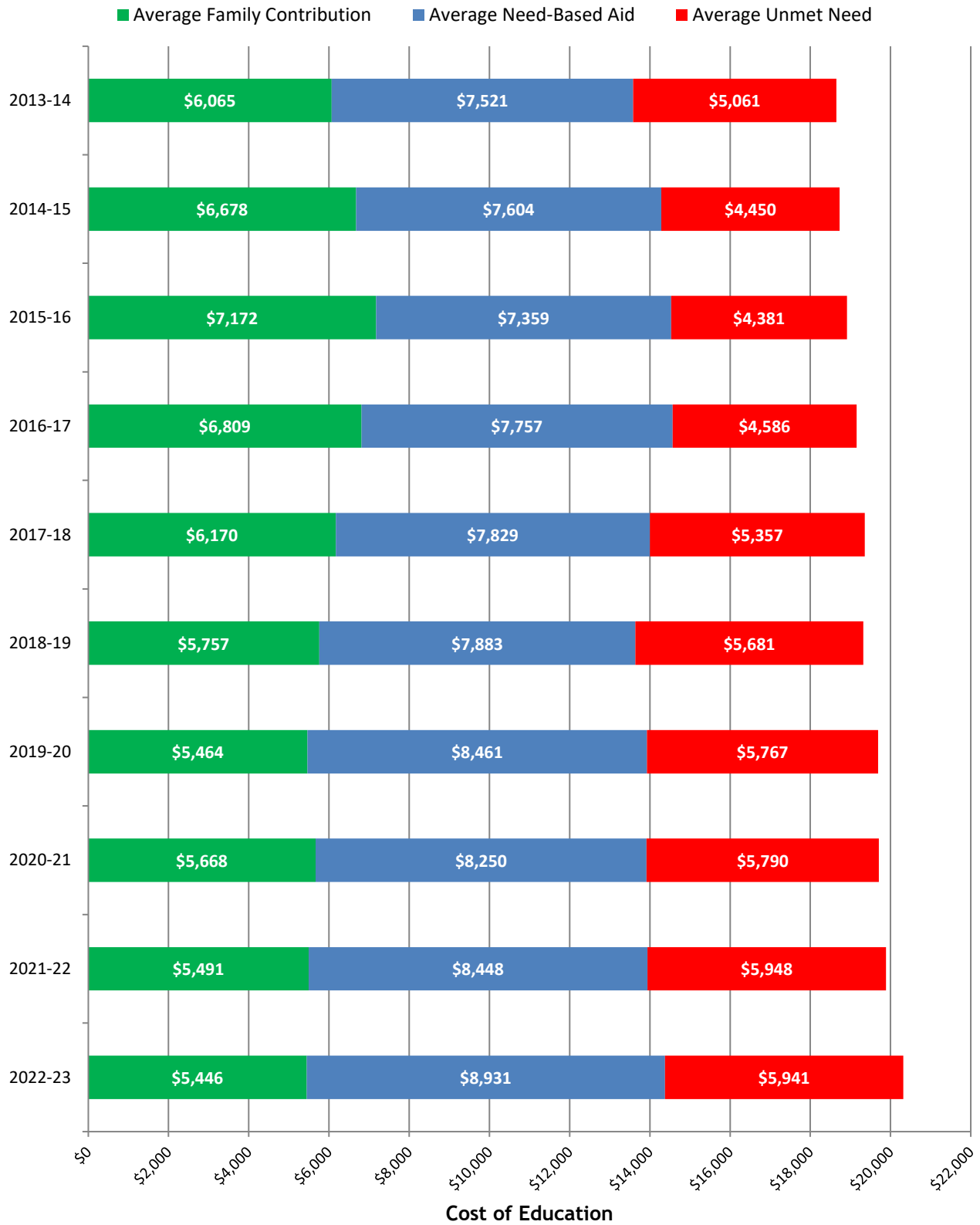

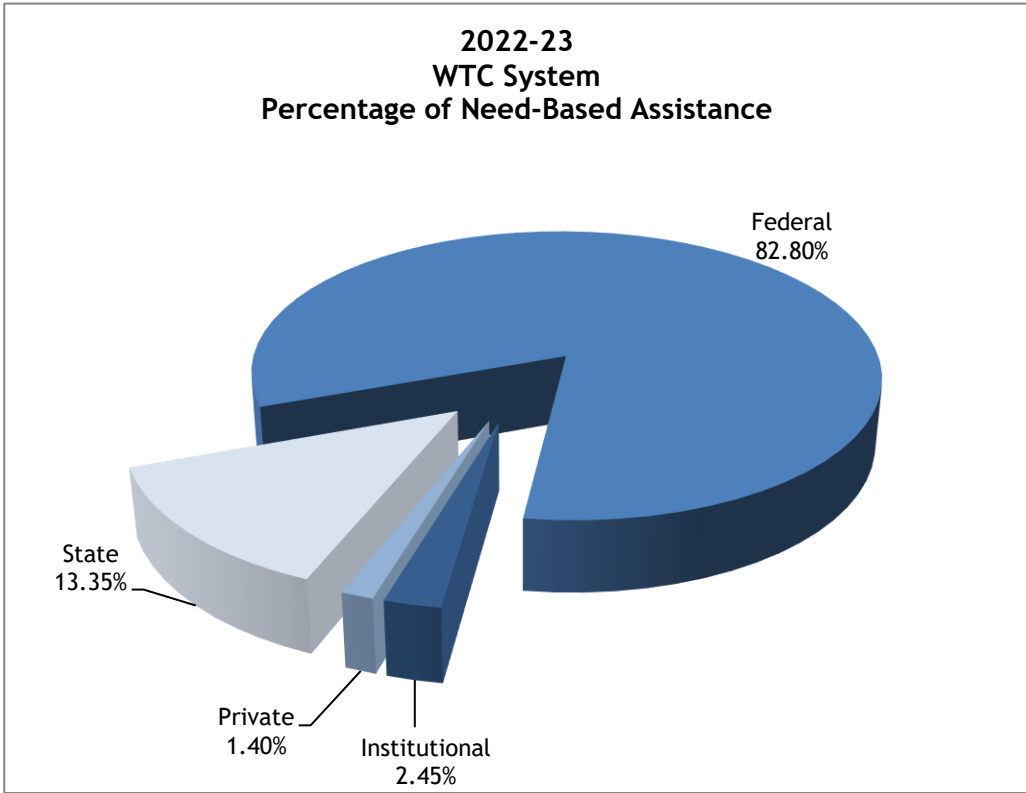
