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Incorrect Social Security Number Issues

There has been and continues to be a large number of Social Security number problems the last couple of years. It appears that students are entering their social security number without proof reading prior to hitting the submit key when they complete their FAFSA information. If you have a student/s that has this problem please review the following –

- 1. Check to see if the student has submitted a SSN correction through the FAFSA; if so please use the secure e-mail on our site to let Barb Moermond or the grant coordinator the name of the student in question; the new SSN; and the old SSN. HEAB does pull in all of the ISIR's but we do not process the SSN corrections.
- 2. If there is a name/SSN mismatch, this means that student A filed under student B's social security number. Please verify the students' SSN and then use the secure e-mail on our site to give us all of the information that you have. We need to have both names, the filing dates that you see, the SSN and verification of who the SSN belongs to.
- 3. If a student changes their name at your school, please verify that it is a legal name change before changing your official records.
